

The GHG protocol standard categorises emissions depending on where they are generated. 7 greenhouse gases are tracked; CO<sub>2</sub>, CH<sub>4</sub>, N<sub>2</sub>O, HFC, PFC, SF<sub>6</sub>, NF<sub>3</sub>; summarised as the equivalent amount of Carbon Dioxide that would give the same warming effect or "CO2e".
